How to Find Journal Articles...

Select Databases: Articles and More

Academic Search Premier (Ebsco)

Academic Search is an interdisciplinary, academic journal database that has some online articles.

Truncation Symbol *

Use the advanced search option for additional search features (full-text, peer-reviewed, and year published are some options).

America History and Life (ABC CLIO)

Indexes and abstracts information about American history. Some full-text links.

Arts and Humanities Search (Firstsearch)

AH Search indexes many humanities articles. Truncation Symbol *

Bibliography of Native North Americans (Silver Platter)

BNNA indexes the literature of the history, culture and life of Native Americans, from sixteenth century forward.

JSTOR

JSTOR is a full-text article database of humanities articles searchable by keyword.

Literature Research Center (Gale)

LRC provides full-text access to various sources such as the Dictionary of Literary Biography (information about authors) and Contemporary Literary Criticism.

MLA Modern Language Association (Ebsco)

The coverage for this literary database is international and “subjects include literature, language and linguistics, folklore, literary theory & criticism, dramatic arts, as well as the historical aspects of printing and publishing. Listings on rhetoric and composition and the history, theory and practice of teaching language and literature are also included.”

Note: *To see if we own a specific electronic journal—or to view a list of the electronic journals we own, choose the Ejournal option under the Articles & More heading. There is a pull-down option for American Indian Studies and English.*

Library Catalog: Books and More

Use the library catalog to see which books, journals, scores, CDs, videos, government documents etc. the UW Libraries own, and where to find them.

The library collection is organized using the Library of Congress system.

Es—Most American Indian-related books and journals are located in this call number area.

American literary books and journals are generally in the PSs. Print government documents are in the basement.

Basic Search: Best when you have exact information, like author or item title.

- A. Keyword Search tab: This is a flexible way to search, with options to limit. Truncation symbol is ?
- B. My Account: View what you currently have out, renew items, place recalls, see if requested holds are in, fines, and more.
- D. Course Reserves: Check for print or online reserves for classes by instructor or class.

Interlibrary Loan

If the UW Libraries does not have an item you need we will try to borrow the item from another library for you.

This service is usually free but we will notify you if there is a charge from the other library and you can decide to pursue the item or not. Please allow time for this process, about 2-3 weeks.
