Academic Search Premier (or other EBSCO databases)

- EBSCO Image Bank (select Images tab): photos of people, nature, places, maps, flags, and historical photos
- Search for cover stories (database doesn't include magazine covers, but will point you to them)

ARTstor

- Largest collection of digital images at UW (400,000+)
- Search entire collection or individual collections (Asian art, Native American art, etc.)

Art Abstracts

- Indexes 300+ leading art publications from around the world
- Comprehensive record of art reproductions
- Under "Refine Search", select "Art Reproduction" as Document Type.

Grove Dictionary of Art Online

- provides web access to the entire text of [The Dictionary of Art](#) (1996, 34 vols.) and [The Oxford Companion to Western Art](#).
- over 3,000 thumbnail art images, line drawings, and links to images accompany articles
- useful search and navigation tools.

Wilson Omnifile Full-Text Select

- search for portraits, color illustrations, cover images and more using the Advanced Search
