## Accessing Library Resources on Clinical Rotations

### Off Campus Access:

- WyoWeb:  
click on Libraries/Archives tab, look for thumbnail of library web page in column on the right
- Direct access to web page: <http://www-lib.uwyo.edu>  
Click on “Off-campus Access” in the column on the right. If you have difficulty accessing resources, you may need to upload Trend Micro PC-cillin, which is accessible from the off-campus access login page. Report any access problems to Coe Reference immediately.

### Requesting Articles:

- Request It!
  - Continue to use the Request It function for Interlibrary Loan and articles that are available in print at the Libraries.
  - Requesting the print books be sent to you may not arrive in a timely manner.
  - In comments field, add “On rotation in \_\_\_\_\_.” Otherwise, they may expect you to pick something up at the circulation desk.
- Loansome Doc:  
If you are not currently using Loansome Doc as a means of requesting articles when using PubMed, this would be a good time to register. <https://docline.gov/loansome/login.cfm>  
When filling out your registration form:
  - Indicate PDF and email as your preferred means of receiving articles
  - You MUST have UWYO in the comments field, or you will be charged per article
  - It is also a good idea to have “On rotation in \_\_\_\_\_” in the comments field
  - Leave the amount you will pay blank. As long as you are registered at UW, we will pay for all Interlibrary Loan and Copyright fees
  - Loansome Doc can be used for articles we do not own and articles we have in print

To order an article using PubMed:

- Perform your search
- Mark the citations of the articles you wish to order
- Use the drop-down menu in the “Send To” box to select “Order”
- Enter your username and password and continue through the screens

### If you cannot access University of Wyoming Libraries' Electronic Resources

- If you can get into the Libraries' web site, have gone through WyoWeb or Off-Campus Access, but are still unable to access databases or e-journals, report the problem to the Reference Desk
- If help is not readily available or if the network is down, you can still access the following databases:
  - PubMed <http://pubmed.gov>
    - Use PubMed to search for articles
    - Links to University of Wyoming Libraries' articles will not be active using this URL.
    - To limit your search to Free Full Text, use the Limits feature and click the box that says “Free Full Text.” Clicking the “Links to Full Text” box will take you to publisher sites that will charge for access to articles
  - ToxNet <http://toxnet.nlm.nih.gov/>
    - Use LactMed for information on medications during lactation
    - Use DART for information on medications during pregnancy
    - Use HSDB for information on carcinogenicity and toxicity of substances/drugs
  - Cochrane <http://gowyld.net/dbases.cfm>
    - You must have a Wyoming County PUBLIC LIBRARY CARD to access Cochrane and the other databases if not going through the UW Libraries web site
    - Use Cochrane when looking for systematic reviews on interventions
  - Orange Book <http://www.fda.gov/cder/orange/default.htm>
  - Pneumotox <http://www.pneumotox.com/>
  - National Guideline Clearing House <http://www.guideline.gov/>

### If you do not have access to the Internet:

- Call Jenny Garcia or Interlibrary Loan and request that information be faxed to your location
