WorldCat (under Articles/Databases, W). Search libraries around the world and request books through interlibrary loan.

To find journal articles click on *Articles / Databases*

Select Articles/Databases covering WMST topics

- *Academic Search Premier*: Interdisciplinary full text journal articles
- *America: History and Life*: Focuses on U.S. history topics.
- *AP Images*: Image database containing thousands of AP photos for educational use.
- *GVRL (Gale Virtual Reference Library)*: Online reference books
- *JSTOR*: Dates of each journal vary, usually from v.1 to 3-5 years prior to current year. 262 titles. Full text.

- **LexisNexis Statistical:** Includes information found in statistical publications of the U.S. Government; American statistical publications from selected private organizations and state government sources; and statistical publications of international intergovernmental organizations.
- **Project Muse:** Current scholarly journals. Dates vary by journal. Some back to 1995.
- **SAGE Full-text Sociology:** All full-text articles.
- **Web of Science. Arts & Humanities, Social Sciences and Sciences:** Citation Index. Use the Find it at UW button to obtain articles.
- **Women's Studies International:** Full-text articles on global WMST issues.
- **Wyoming Magazine Prospector:** Indexes articles in Wyoming sources.

‡ The library has 200+ databases. Librarians can point you to appropriate databases depending on your topic.

Evaluate Your Information What is the purpose of the information?

- Is the author pushing an agenda? What are the author's credentials? Is he/she associated with a reputable organization?
- Does he/she cite sources to support a point of view?
- Does this information fit in with what you already know, or do others support it?
- How current is the information?
- What is the intended audience for the article, book, paper, or website?

Give credit to your source, whether it's a print source, a web site, or someone's voiced opinion in class. The following link on the UW Library webpage has more information on online and print style guides.
